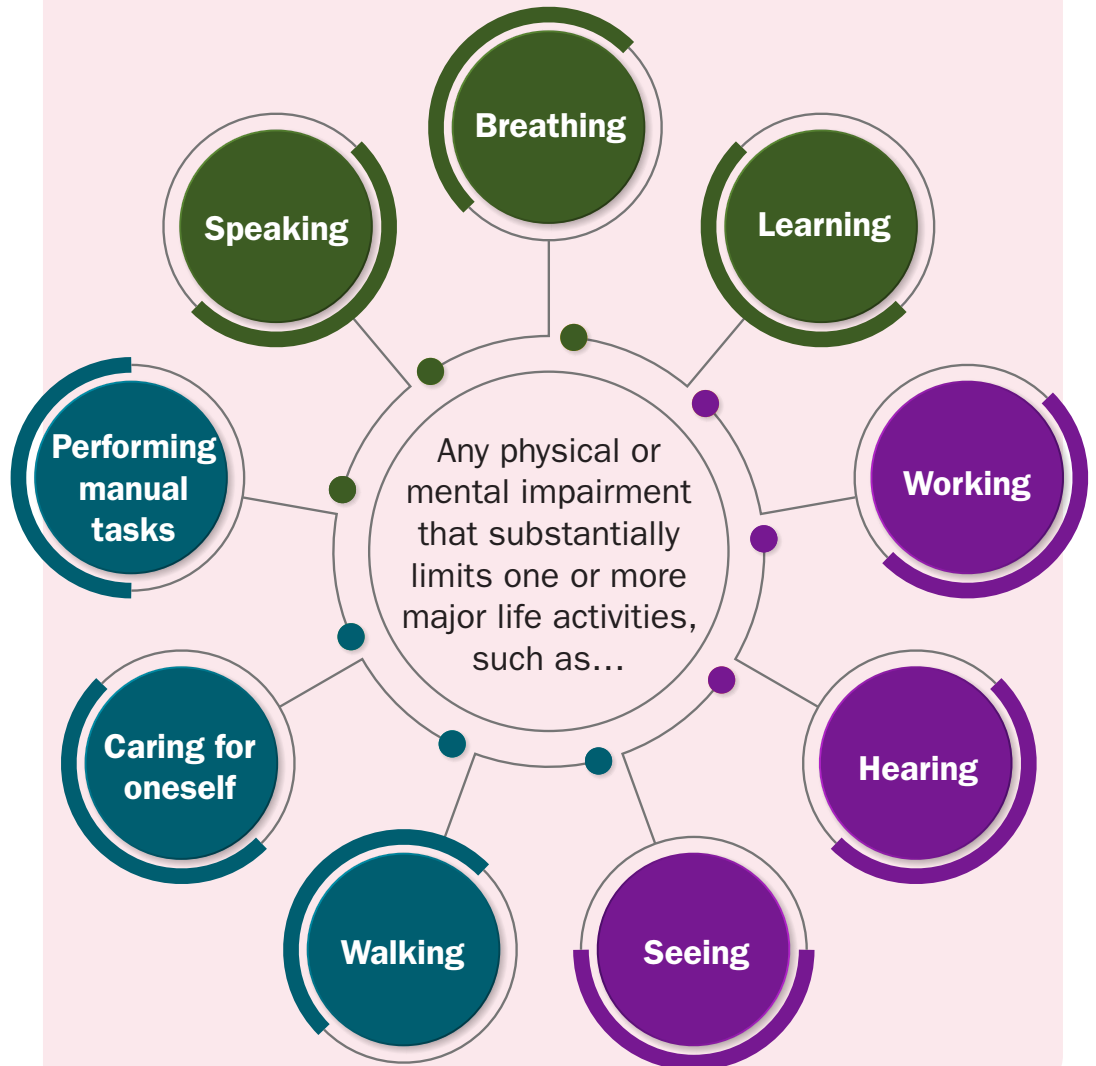

Registering with Disability Services

- Apply to the college.
- Take the college placement tests (if applicable).
- Complete intake form at https://cm.maxient.com/reportingform.php?JolietJuniorCollege&layout_id=3
- Submit disability documentation for approval. Documentation can be attached to the intake form, faxed to the office, mailed, emailed or dropped off in person.
- Once documentation is approved, Disability Services will contact you to schedule an intake appointment to discuss accommodations.

Placement Test Accommodations

There are three placement tests: reading, writing and math. Each test may be taken at different times/days to best meet the student's needs.

Since the placement tests are all untimed, the accommodation of having extended test time is not necessary.

If you feel you may need additional accommodations on the placement test, please contact Disability Services to discuss what accommodations are needed.
